

Week 9: Ministry Tools.

2 Timothy 3:16–17 · Tasks drop **Mon / Wed / Fri** (20–30 min each) · one 90-second drill a day if it serves you · the **Audit** closes the week **Saturday** · Sundays off.

This week: Sermon to weekly actions; a ten-minute Scripture-study loop with AI as partner; a teaching aid you'll actually use Sunday.

MONDAY — TASK 1 · Sermon › Watchman's Actions (20–30 min)

This Sunday's sermon becomes five actions you'll do this week.

- 1. Capture this Sunday's sermon — your notes, the passage, or the recording.
- 2. Ask AI to pull out the actionable commands and applications, not just the themes.
- 3. Sharpen them into five specific actions with a day attached to each.
- 4. Do them this week. Report one in the channel that you completed.

WEDNESDAY — TASK 2 · 10-Minute Scripture Study with AI (20–30 min)

Claude is the study partner, not the teacher. Learn to ask.

- 1. Pick one passage you want to understand more deeply.
- 2. Use AI as a study partner — ask it for: *(the steps are on the task card)*
- 3. Form your own understanding from the study — don't just accept the AI's summary.
- 4. Test what you learned against trusted commentary or your pastor. AI can be confidently wrong about Scripture.

FRIDAY — TASK 3 · Build a Teaching Aid for One Passage (20–30 min)

A handout, discussion questions, application points. Use it Sunday.

- 1. Pick a passage you'd actually teach and your audience for it.
- 2. Have AI help generate a handout, 4–6 discussion questions, and 2–3 application points.
- 3. Refine it against your own study (W9.T2) — cut anything that's thin or off.
- 4. Use it this Sunday or next. Note what landed for the next time you teach.

SATURDAY — The Watchman's Audit (15 min)

- The standing Week-2 rhythm: AI summarizes the week's logs and prompts; you read it honestly — no explaining away the slips.
- Set ONE anchor for next week. Then take Sunday off — rest is part of the post.

THE LINE TO HOLD

AI is a fast concordance, never the authority. The Word judges the tool's output — keep the order straight. — “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine.” (2 Timothy 3:16)

This week's drills (optional — 90 seconds, one a day)

Sermon action. Take one point from Sunday's sermon. Turn it into one action with a day attached. Do it.

Better question. Pick a familiar verse. Ask AI for three questions a careful teacher would ask of it. Answer one yourself.

Teach one point. Draft one discussion question and one application for a passage you'd teach. Use it this week.
